

Things to think about for week one

- **First Day of School, Monday Aug. 23**
 - All freshman report to Lowery at 8:15
 - All upperclassmen report at 8:00
 - Each student will need to go to their Student Access in Skyward and print off a new schedule showing their teacher and room number for the first day of school.
 - All students should bring instruments. (no morning marching today only)
 - Due to the construction at AHS, please be sure to review the “Escadrille Traffic Map 2010” included.
- **Monday Night Rehearsal**
 - 6:00-8:00 p.m. at Eagle Stadium (at Lowery)
 - Everyone attends
 - Drop off and parking are a challenge due to freshman football. Plan ahead.
 - Bring instrument, music, equipment, water and plain white t-shirt.
 - Parents are always invited.
- **Tuesday -Friday**
 - Regular rehearsal each morning at 7:00 a.m.
 - Drop off and park in designated areas only.
 - Crossing guard on duty. Stop for pedestrian traffic.
 - Almost 700 students/staff arriving simultaneously. Plan ahead.
 - Freshman will bus to LFC at approx. 8:50 a.m.
 - All students will have an opportunity to “freshen up” for 2nd period.
- **Students in AHS/LFC sports**
 - Conflicts with Band/Athletic Practices schedules will be resolved and finalized during week one. Most are already completed.
 - It is the student’s responsibility to keep up with schedules and assignments.
 - Communication is key to making this work.
- **First Football Game – Allen vs. Cedar Hill**
 - Saturday, August 28 – SMU Ford Stadium @ 7:30 p.m.
 - Run-through begins promptly at 4:30 p.m. at the practice field.
 - Students should arrive in full uniform – WHITE with white shoes, socks and t-shirts. Color Guard will receive uniform information from Mrs. Rohr. Students not in proper uniform are not permitted to march.
 - Students should eat a good lunch before arriving. A light dinner will be provided following run-through along with a snack after halftime.
 - Students are not permitted to bring outside snacks, candy, food or drink nor may they receive any of the above from concessions. Medical exceptions may be permitted with proper documentation and communication.
 - All students must ride to and from all events using school transportation.

ALLEN HIGH SCHOOL TRAFFIC MAP

The pick-up and drop-off traffic patterns have been changed due to construction on the high school property for 2010-2011. Enter the property from Exchange, Greenville or Cedar Street (Allen Station Park). The entrance at the east end of the property (1) can only be used for exiting. No left turns will be allowed. The main entrance (2) will now be open for two way traffic in front of the school. The west entrance (3) will remain as a two-way entrance and a new entrance has been created (4) for traffic coming from Allen Station Park. Allow extra time for arrival the first weeks of school as students and parents adjust to the new patterns. Please be patient and drive safely as we work through this year of construction.

For Escadrille Practice at 7:00 a.m. please follow the green and yellow traffic patterns. Always stop for pedestrian traffic. Do not drop off or pick up in the street at anytime.
